

WSYSA D2 Youth Soccer Quick Reference Guide

General Information

Please use the D2 Youth Soccer website, www.wsysad2.org, for all schedules. This is the only site that will have the complete schedule including home and away games. The schedules are subject to change. Please check the website before each week's game to ensure you have the most up to date information. Your team will play 10 games during the season, barring any unforeseen circumstances. D2 pairs the teams for play and selects the day, but the associations schedule the exact details such as the time and field. The entire schedule will not be available at the beginning of the season due to scheduling logistics so please be sure to check back for updates. No login is required to view the schedules and standings on www.wsyad2.org. They are available to everyone.

To Reset Password

- Select Reset Password
- Enter your SiteName and email address into appropriate boxes and click request

To Report Score (Login required)

- Select Coach
- Select Scores
- Select the appropriate game # link
- Enter both scores and # of cards
- Please note: *Both coaches need to enter scores; the standings play an important role in determining future divisions*

To Edit Coach Information (Login required)

- Select Services
- Select Profile
- A phone number and email address must be 'released' (place a checkmark in the box) for other coaches to access
- Address information is required for disciplinary purposes and does not need to be 'released' (do not need to check box)
- Please note: Do not modify the team info in the notes field

Contacting Coaches (Login required)

- Contact the opposing coach before each game to touch base and verify match details
- To find contact information for coaches-
 - Find the team you are playing
 - Go to Coaches -> Teams filter for your opponent
- Contact with team/field info for upcoming match (week of match)

FAQs

What associations are in D2?

- EYSA (Eastside, comprised of BUFC, IFC, LHSC, NYSC, and MIFC)
- LWYSA (Lake Washington)
- NYSA (Northshore)
- SnVYSA (Snoqualmie Valley)
- These are the teams you will be playing in D2. This will involve travel to these associations when you are the away team.

Registration and Information

- All players, coaches, assistant coaches, and managers register through their individual associations.
- Players can be rostered to only one United States Soccer Federation (USSF) affiliated team at a time.
- Concussion Compliance, Cardiac Arrest and RMA (coach risk management clearance) are all done with individual associations registration process.
- Teams are formed at the association level.
- The above information is forwarded to D2 to form leagues.

What does D2 do with this information?

- D2 creates divisions of teams for seasonal play.
- Information for division placement is taken from your league record from last season.

Who schedules practice time, games time/locations, and provides information to the referees?

- All practice time is scheduled by your association.
- D2 forwards game dates for your team to your association who then schedules your fields, game times, and notifies the referees.

How do I see my game dates, times, and locations?

- Each association will ONLY post home games on their site.
- D2 will post ALL home and away games at www.wsysad2.org
- Note: *Not all games will be posted right away. Many associations cannot schedule out more than a few weeks ahead due to field issues.*
- Always check your upcoming match information the week before your game.
- Contact your opponent the week of the match to verify time, location, and team colors.
- Game Days (League):
 - Sat: GU13-GU15, BU13
 - Sun: GU16-GU19, BU14-BU19

What do I need to do on game day?

- Complete roster (found at www.wsysad2.org/publicdocuments) and give to the referee.
- Home team provides match ball and changes color in case of conflict.
- No cards are needed for league play.
- Ideally all players and coaches for both teams will be on one side of the field with spectators on the opposite side.

Who reports game results?

- EACH TEAM must report their match results online at the D2 site, www.wsysad2.org.
- All misconduct cards must be reported by both teams when reporting scores. (See WSYSA D2 Quick Reference Guide for 'how to' information)
- Teams that consistently do not report results may have penalties assessed.

Who answers what questions?

- Associations answer:
 - Player and/or coach registration issues as well as team formation questions.
 - Coach RMA status (risk management).
 - Field time and location issues.
 - Game rescheduling.
- D2 answers:
 - Division placement
 - Discrepancy of game time, location, or score on the D2 website.
 - Forward disciplinary issues to chairman for response.
